



The Lysaght Watt Trust Art Award 2018

CONDITIONS of ENTRY

- 1) **ONE** entry per artist. The theme for this competition is **‘Rising’** and all entries must comply with this theme. Entry Forms to be received by 29 March 2018.
- 2) The competition is open to both two dimensional works and three dimensional works in any media.
 - a) The longest side of a 2D work is not to exceed 1000mm and the depth (front to back) is not to exceed 100mm.
 - b) 3D work must not exceed 1000mm in any direction.
 - c) The weight of any work intended to be hung must not exceed 10kg.
 - d) 3D works are expected to be less than 15 kg.
 - e) Heavier works will be considered but this must be discussed with the Lysaght Watt Gallery prior to the entry being accepted.
 - f) Entries that require a TV or a monitor are unable to be accepted.
 - g) Any entries requiring electrical connections must pass safety standards.
- 3) 2D work may be framed or unframed but must be able to be hung using substantial D-rings, hooks or eyes, preferably 70mm from the top.
- 4) Both 2D & 3D works will be eligible for the major overall award of \$3,000.
- 5) Works that have been previously exhibited in Taranaki or Whanganui will not be accepted.
- 6) All works must be for sale. Prices are to be shown on the entry form and must include G.S.T. if any. The Lysaght Watt Gallery will charge a commission of 25% on the actual sale price of the art works sold.
- 7) All works selected, including works which have been sold, must remain on display for the full term of the exhibition. The exhibition will run from Thursday, 4th May until Sunday 10th June, 2018

- 8) All work must be clearly labeled on the back with the artist's name, address, date and title.
- 9) STAGE Inc. (South Taranaki Art Gallery and Exhibitions Inc.), as the owners of the Lysaght Watt Gallery, will take all care of entries but will not accept any responsibility for any loss or damage which may occur. Artists should arrange their own insurance.
- 10) Entries may be subject to selection before exhibition in the Gallery.
- 11) Entries are to be delivered to the Lysaght Watt Gallery between the 23rd and 26th of April 2018, between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m.

- 12) There is an entry fee of \$45 which covers Gallery and Award administration costs and includes the cost of returning the artwork to the artist if not sold.
- 13) The judge's decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 14) The organisers have the right to use photographs of artworks for promotional and advertising purposes for this or subsequent exhibitions.
