Conditions of Entry

1. Entries are limited to **ONE** entry per artist. This year's theme is "**Time Out**" and all entries must comply with the theme. Entry forms must be received by **Sunday 17 May 2020** and late entries will **not** be accepted.
2. The competition is open to both two dimensional works and three dimensional works in any media.
 - a. The longest side of a 2D work is not to exceed 1000mm and the depth (front to back) is not to exceed 100mm.
 - b. 3D work must not exceed 1000mm in any direction.
 - c. The weight of any work intended to be hung must not exceed 10kg.
 - d. 3D works are expected to be less than 15 kg.
 - e. Heavier works will be considered but this must be discussed with the Lysaght Watt Gallery prior to the entry being accepted.
3. All artwork must be for sale. Commission of 25% will be charged on all sales (and GST if applicable) and must be included in the sales price shown on your entry form. If you are GST registered, please provide your GST number.
4. Artwork that has previously been exhibited in Taranaki or Whanganui will not be accepted. The artwork must be the artist's own and is not copied from the artwork of any other artist.
5. Entries may be subject to selection before exhibition in the Gallery. The organisers have the right to refuse offensive or inappropriate material
6. All works selected, including works which have been sold, must remain on display for the full term of the exhibition. The exhibition will run from **Saturday 27 June - Saturday 25 July 2020**.
7. Both 2D & 3D works will be eligible for the major overall award of \$3,000.
8. Entries will be judged in the category in which they are entered. If artwork is ineligible for the entered category, the artist will be contacted by the organisers.
9. STAGE Inc. (South Taranaki Art Gallery and Exhibitions Inc.), as the owners of the Lysaght Watt Gallery, will take all care of entries but will not accept responsibility or liability for any loss or damage which may occur. Artists are responsible for arranging insurance of their artwork.
10. All artwork must be ready to hang or display. 2D work may be framed or unframed but must have weight specific D-rings attached, preferably 70mm from the top. Artwork not ready to hang or display will be disqualified. Wet artwork will not be accepted.
11. All artwork must be of a size easily handled by two people. Heavy wall artwork may place a strain on our hanging system and may therefore be displayed on an easel.

12. Sculptures being displayed on a plinth may need to include a supporting stand or mount to ensure they are secure and stable when freestanding. This is the responsibility of the artist to provide.
13. Minimal on-site assembly of artwork is permitted. Artists are not able to recreate installations onsite.
14. All artwork must be clearly labelled on the back with the artist's name, address, date and title.
15. Incorrect entry procedure or failure to observe the conditions may, at the discretion of the organisers, disqualify an entry.
16. The judge's decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into. The judging panel is independent of the organisers.
17. The organisers have the right to use photographs of artwork for promotional and advertising purposes (including our website) for this or subsequent exhibitions.

Delivery and Collection

1. Entries are to be delivered to Lysaght Watt Gallery, 4-6 Union Street, Hawera, 10.00 am - 4.00 pm, **Monday 15 – Friday 19 June 2020**.
2. Artwork must be securely packaged and delivered free of all charges with a PRE-PAID return freight ticket included. No payment will be made by Lysaght Watt Gallery for freight or other charges incurred in the delivery or return of artwork.
3. Artists will be contacted if their artwork is sold. We will return your PRE-PAID courier ticket by post together with payment of net sale proceeds.
4. Unsold artwork must be collected from Lysaght Watt Gallery, 4-6 Union Street, Hawera, 10.00 am - 4.00 pm, **Monday 27 July – Friday 31 July 2020**.
5. The organisers have the right to sell or otherwise dispose of unclaimed artwork.

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
